

10-Month postdoc opportunity working at the intersection of art and heritage

The Netherlands Institute for Sound and Vision in collaboration with VU Amsterdam is looking for a post-doc to carry out a 10-month project collaborating with artists to explore the intangible heritage surrounding analogue audiovisual production. The goal of the project is to understand how we can preserve the tacit knowledge of audiovisual production for future generations of artists and makers. The postdoc will research, organize and document two co-creation workshops together with audiovisual artists and (past) users of production equipment, aimed at producing archive of tacit knowledge. The project is part of the NWA Route Kunst project "Artists Community Knowledge" (ACKnowledge). The post will be based at the Netherlands Institute for Sound and Vision and co-supervised from the Faculty of Humanities at the VU Amsterdam, and aims to start by November 15.
